



WEBSITE PRIVACY STATEMENT

This privacy statement is provided to make you aware of how Digirock collects uses and manages personal information of visitors to and users of Digirock's websites. Protecting your privacy is very important and Digirock is committed to maintaining the security of personal information provided to Digirock by visitors using its websites.

By using Digirock's website and by agreeing to this Privacy Statement you consent to the collection, use and disclosure of your personal information as described by this document. If you do not consent, do not use any of the services provided by Digirock or its applications. Digirock's recognises and respects the Privacy of all our Users, so please take a few minutes to read through this Privacy Statement. This Internet Privacy Statement is in addition to any other terms and conditions applicable to the web site.

1 <u>Collecting Information</u>

As part of registering, we collect some personal information about you in order for you to take full advantage of our services. To do this it may be necessary for you to provide additional information to us including that outlined below.

1.1 Registration

Registration on our website is completely optional but may include submitting:

- Your name;
- Email address;
- Company address;
- Telephone number;
- The option of receiving updates and promotional material; and
- Other information to complete company documents.

You may access this information at any time by logging in and going to your account.

1.1 Credit Card Details

We will use commercially reasonable methods to keep Personally Identifiable Information securely in our files and systems. Our Payment System is operated using secure Internet connections, including SSL (Secure Sockets Layer) encryption, to protect your financial data.

2 Personal Information

Your personal information is only collected when you voluntarily and knowingly submit it. This information is collected to provide you with, for example; requested services or to answer or forward any requests or enquiries. It is our intention that this statement will protect your personal information from being used in any way that is inconsistent with applicable Australian privacy laws.

3 <u>Non-personal Information</u>

Cookies and Applets

Digirock also use some information in order to provide you with a personalised experience



when you visit its Internet websites. Through the use of cookies, Digirock can record the pages you visit and the information you require. This aggregate, non-personal information is used anonymously and is collected and logged for statistical purposes. Through analysis of these records, Digirock provides you with an improved service when you revisit its Internet websites.

4 Use of Information

Your personal information, submitted to our site will only be used for the purpose for which it is submitted or for other purposes that are related to the primary purpose, unless we disclose other uses in this Internet Privacy Statement or at the time of collection. Personal information that is contained in copies of correspondence sent or received from the web site, are stored as archives for back-up and record-keeping only.

5 <u>Disclosure</u>

With the exception of where you have consented or disclosure is necessary to achieve the purpose for which it was submitted, personal information may be disclosed in special situations. This may include:

- To meet any applicable law, regulation, legal process or enforceable governmental request;
- To enforce applicable Terms of Service, including investigation of potential violations;
- To detect, prevent, or otherwise address fraud, security or technical issues;
- To protect against harm to the rights, property or safety of Digirock, our Users or the public as required or permitted by law.

Where we engage third parties to provide you with goods or services on our behalf, we may disclose your personal information to those third parties in order to meet your request.

When you contact Digirock, we may keep a record of your communication to help solve any issues you might be facing. We may use your email address to inform you about our services, such as letting you know about upcoming changes or improvements.

6 Access to Personal Information

Whenever you use our services, we aim to provide you with access to your personal information. If that information is wrong, we strive to give you ways to update it quickly or to delete it – unless we have to keep that information for legitimate business or legal purposes. When updating your personal information, we may ask you to verify your identity before we can act on your request.

We may reject requests that are unreasonably repetitive, require disproportionate technical effort (for example, developing a new system or fundamentally changing on existing practice), risk the privacy of others, or would be extremely impractical (for example requests concerning information residing on backup tapes).

Where we provide information access and correction, we will do so for free, except where it would require a disproportionate effort. We aim to maintain our services in a manner that protects information from accidental or malicious destruction. Because of this, after you delete information from our services, we may not immediately delete residual copies from our servers and may not remove information from our backup systems.
